July 9, 2018

- 1) The meeting was called to order by Mayor Daryl Behrends.
- 2) Members and Guests Present: Mayor; Daryl Behrends, Council members; Alan Van Dam, Robert Prins, LeRoy Buys, and Faye Schuur; Clerk, Kris Gunnink; City Maintenance/waste water supervisor, Jeff Gunnink; County Sheriff Office, Donna Mollema and Jannette Engels; DSI, Teresa Schreurs and Hunter Robinson.
- 3) Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
- 4) Bob Prins opened the meeting with prayer.
- 5) Faye Schuur moved to approve the Minutes of the June 11, 2018 City Council meeting. Seconded by LeRoy Buys. Motion carried.
